KPI Targets


- Share initiations per article view increase from 0.4% to 0.6%*.
- Overall pages per visit increase from 1.8 to 2.7.
- Overall ad viewability increase from 53% to 70%, dependent on impact to impressions.


* Share initiations measured via Omniture by dividing total clicks/taps on share buttons by total article pageviews.


